AN AMERICAN IN LEIPZIG

Joseph Gaines, a native Houstonian, graduated *Summa Cum Laude* from the University of Houston in 2001 with a Bachelor of Music degree in Vocal Performance. A student of both the university's Moores School of Music and the Honors College, he devoted time to volunteering as a peer counselor for incoming freshmen and in promoting both the university and the city of Houston in recruiting and public relations events. During his studies at the university, he was active as a singer in church and synagogue choirs and as a soloist throughout the greater Houston area, including the choir of St. Paul's United Methodist Church and the Bach Choir of Christ the King Lutheran Church.

In October of 2001, Mr. Gaines was awarded an Ambassadorial Fellowship from the Rotary Foundation and relocated to Leipzig, Germany, to study singing for two semesters at the Hochschule für Musik und Theater "Felix Mendelssohn-Bartholdy." In addition to his concert and opera performances at the Hochschule, he was very active as a concert throughout eastern and soloist Germany and Denmark. His other projects during this time include a six-month online Journal" "Leipzig and an independent documentary film project Kunst in der Republik (Art during the Republic), currently in production by Romanstyle Films in New York. The film is expected to debut at the 46th Annual Leipzig International Festival for Documentary and Animated Film in October of 2003.

Mr. Gaines currently resides in the Washington, D.C. area, where he is a soloist for St. Paul's Parish, K-Street and for the Washington Bach Consort. He was recently a finalist in the New York auditions for the Merola Young Artist Program of the San Francisco Opera.

DID YOU KNOW THAT...

The hour of birth of the Leipzig Opera came as early as 1693, which makes it the third-oldest musical stage in Europe after Milan and Hamburg. In 1993 the Leipzig Opera was made "Opera of the Year".
