Joerg Henning Meyer was born in Bad Segeberg, Schleswig Holstein, and grew up in Essen as the middle child of his father, a coal mining engineer, and his mother, a pediatric nurse. After his high school diploma (Abitur) he served in the German Navy for 15 months. He studied geophysics at the University of Kiel (CAU) and University of Munich (LMU).
