

## Who are we?

Safespace Leipzig is a collective of Leipzig volunteers who work together to found, organize, and establish a support system in their city for people with a wide range of needs.

With the arrival of numerous refugees from Ukraine in Leipzig, the Safe Space was founded and can now be found in the premises of the socio-cultural center „Die Villa“. Through extensive networking in social media, we can build on a broad community.

Safe Space Leipzig tries to be as safe as possible for all those seeking protection. We are aware that we can never be a discrimination-free and thus fully safe place.







## What we do

**Providing** - It all started with a pot of soup - now we provide several hundred people with hot and cold meals, drinks, hygiene articles and clothing every day.

**Gathering** - In a very short time, Safe Space Leipzig became a social and communal place where meeting and exchange as well as participation in regularly changing actions and workshops are made possible.

**Networking** - In and with Safe Space Leipzig, various local and supra-regional partners are connected, including committed individuals, companies, municipal institutions and relevant associations.



## How we work

Due to its history, Safe Space Leipzig is primarily visited by refugees from Ukraine. However, we do not differentiate between the people who come to us according to age, gender, nationality, skin color or religion.

Safe Space Leipzig aims to be a low barrier, low hierarchy and low discrimination contact point for people with a wide range of concerns and to provide prompt and uncomplicated help.

In an activist-participative self-image, we try to empower refugees and people seeking help to initiate change processes themselves and to enable participation and involvement in social life. In this sense, refugees are now also part of our collective and work actively with us.







## What we need

Every day we give out around 400 portions of warm food, 80 liters of coffee, 150 sandwiches, 35 kg of fruit and vegetables and much more. The provision presents us with both logistical and financial challenges, because we finance ourselves 100% from private donations.
